

Mountain Brook Lamprey

Characteristics

- one slightly notched dorsal fin (*American Brook* has two fins)
- 57-60 trunk myomeres, counting and including first myomere after last gill-opening to last myomere before anus
- non-parasitic with oral disc narrower than body
- moderately well-developed disc teeth

Ecology and Distribution

- adults in gravel riffles and sandy runs of clean, clear high-gradient streams
- ammocetes in sand, mud, and debris in pools and backwaters
