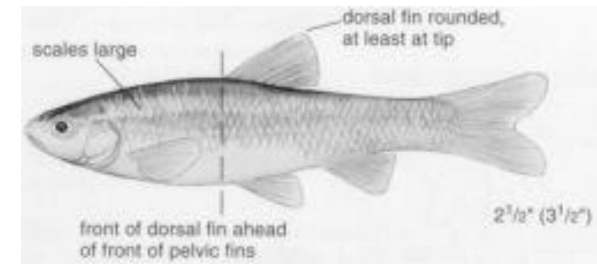

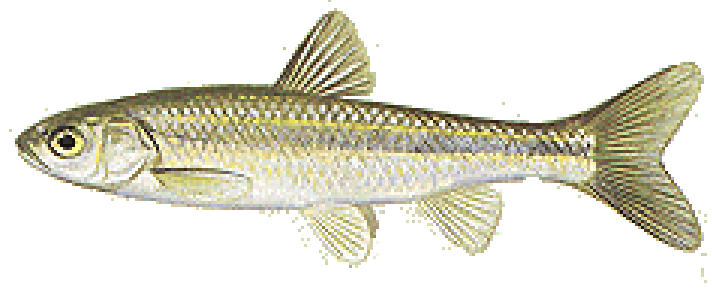
Brassy Minnow

Hybognathus hankinsoni



Characteristics

- stout, brassy-yellow body; small, subterminal mouth
- rounded dorsal fin; insertion in front of pelvic fins
- body somewhat compressed & deepest & widest in front of dorsal fin
- dusky olive above w/ yellow-green stripe along back; brassy yellow side
- scales large, fewer than 40 in lateral series



Ecology and Distribution

- introduced as bait fish & reported in some lakes; status unclear in FCW streams
- found in slow moving streams w/ silt bottoms
