

Hornyhead Chub Nocomis biguttatus

Characteristics

- -small, conical barbel at posterior upper end of jaw
- -tip of upper jaw separated from snout by a deep groove
- -breeding adults have a squarish red or carmine spot behind eye
- -breeding male brightly colored with pink, orange, and blue; has tubercles on head, extending back to nape
- -dark spot at base of tail (A)
- -snout length shorter (B) than head length from the eye back (C)

Ecology and Distribution

- -rocky pools and runs of small to medium rivers
- -very common in streams of FCW, prefers clear & gravel moderate to large imbus.on.us/aquation sized streams
- -spawning occurs from late May through June
