


Golden Redhorse Moxostoma erythrurum

Characteristics

- elongate body; slightly concave dorsal fin; short caudal peduncle (vs. black redhorse)*
- fewer than 50 lateral line scales; no dark spots on scale bases*
- 12-13 dorsal fins rays*; vs. 14-16 in silver redhorse
- plicate lips w/ V-shape on rear of lower lip;
 not papillose like silver redhorse
- dusky olive above; yellow brassy side
 w/ pale green reflections
- mostly gray caudal fin (orange in juveniles);
 orange to yellow anal & paired fins;
- breeding male w/ dark stripe; salmon fins; tubercles on head

Ecology and Distribution

- gravelly to rocky pools & runs in medium to large rivers
- relatively common species in FC main stem
